

The MVP Strong Families program, facilitated by the Polis Institute on behalf of Florida Citrus Sports and other key stakeholders, was established to strengthen families through direct engagement and strategic community partnerships. The program aimed to create a comprehensive support network to cultivate parent advocacy, promote healthy child development, and provide accessible resources for caregivers and youth. Network members included early learning centers, schools, and family-serving organizations.



The initiative focused on reducing service silos and ensuring families—particularly those historically marginalized—have equitable access to quality programs that encourage long-term resilience and leadership within the home and broader community.

Guided by this mission, the network successfully coordinated and implemented a series of events and engagement opportunities designed to meet families where they are—both geographically and emotionally. Over the course of the grant period, the program hosted 19 partner-led community events, each tailored to promote connection, learning, and joy.

To better understand the program's effectiveness and relevance, an end-of-year survey was administered to all participating partners. The results strongly affirmed that the program achieved its intended outcomes and significantly enriched the work of partner organizations.

- **100%** of partners agreed the initiative strengthened their relationships with families.
- **80%** reported that participation enabled them to offer services they would not have otherwise been able to provide.
- Satisfaction with attendance and participation was high, with **80%** strongly agreeing and the remaining **20%** somewhat agreeing that events were well-attended and meaningful.
- Additionally, 100% of partners found the quarterly network meetings to be both valuable and convenient, with 80% reporting they formed at least one new, beneficial partnership through these gatherings.
- **80%** of respondents indicated they actively shared event invitations and resources with other organizations, further amplifying the program's collective impact.

These findings underscore not only the program's direct value to families, but also its role in strengthening the infrastructure of local service providers through collaboration and shared learning.







Central to the program's success was the deep collaboration among a diverse group of mission-aligned partners. Each organization contributed specialized expertise and services, creating a holistic, wraparound experience for families.









Together, these partners created a dynamic, responsive network that expanded the program's reach and deepened its impact in meaningful, measurable ways.


